

Scouting Heritage

Come prepared with the following:

§ Read the merit badge book and fill in answers to *all* the requirements using a merit badge workbook found on the Internet, and come prepared to show the completed workbook to your Counselor. The merit badge workbook can be found at meritbadge.org or usscouts.org. Bring a copy of the *Scouting Heritage* merit badge pamphlet if you have one.

§ For requirement 4, you have several options. If you choose to contact the Boy Scout National Museum, please do this several weeks in advance of the class. However, you can now visit the North Star Museum to fulfill this requirement, but should do so in advance of the workshop.

§ Concerning requirement 6, bring at least part of your collection to briefly show and explain to the group.

§ Concerning requirement 7, teach and play the game with other Scouts prior to the merit badge workshop, and bring some part of the equipment to show and explain to the class.

§ Concerning requirement 8, if you are not able to interview at least three people over age 40 who were Scouts, we will provide you with an opportunity to interview one of the three people at the workshop.

§ Wear your Scout uniform

§ Bring a properly filled-in and signed merit badge card

§ Bring a pencil or pen

You are expected to do your best to meet each requirement. The class will be spent in group discussion with each Scout expected to participate.
