Come prepared with the following:

- Bring a copy of the Citizenship in the Community merit badge pamphlet. The pamphlet may be purchased at Basecamp. You can also purchase a Kindle version at amazon.com. Make sure you order the most recent version.
- Read the pamphlet before our meeting and review the Requirements 1 & 6: Be prepared to discuss at the workshop
- Requirements 2-5, 7, and 8 require work outside the workshop. Complete these projects before the workshop, bring the results and be prepared to discuss them. Remember that if aspects are not completed and brought to the workshop you will need to meet with the counselor again at a later period. Completed requirements will be signed off. You may download the worksheets for the Merit Badge at <http://usscouts.org/mb/worksheets/Citizenship-in-Society.pdf>. This worksheet can be filled in on your computer. Save it to your hard drive. You will be able to email it to your counselor in advance at jandscapecchi@centurylink.net. If you email it, please do so at least two days prior to the workshop to give him time to look at it. Bring a printout to the class.
- Ideally, we will spend most of the time talking about what you have found and produced prior to the meeting.
- If you plan to present a PowerPoint, bring it on a flash drive.
- Bring a notebook and some pencils
- Wear your uniform
- Bring a merit badge card signed by your Scoutmaster (Blue Card).

Scouts will be signed off only on those requirements that the Merit Badge Counselor determines have been met. We expect the Scouts attending this workshop to come prepared, having read the merit badge pamphlet, and completed the workbook for the requirements indicated.
