To prepare for your merit badge workshop:

- Purchase a copy of the Citizenship in the World merit badge pamphlet at the Scout Shop or on Amazon.com for the Kindle app. It is an excellent resource.
- Read the Merit Badge Pamphlet and use it to complete the Citizenship in the World Workbook. To download the workbook, click on the following link: <http://www.usscouts.org/mb/worksheets/citizenship-in-the-world.PDF>. This is a fillable document. Just save it to your computer under a different name.

Here is what you should bring to your merit badge workshop:

- Bring a print-out of your merit badge workbook
- Wear your Scout uniform
- Bring a merit badge card that is filled out and signed by your Scoutmaster
- Bring a notebook and pencils or a pen so you can take notes

Additional Important Information:

Your counselor requests that you review the merit badge pamphlet before attending class and that you prepare as much as possible to give yourself an opportunity to earn the badge on the day of class. You can (and should) get a head start on your preparation by downloading the Citizenship in the World Merit Badge Workbook and completing what you can before class. At the end of the workbook, you will find additional links that will supplement your review of the requirements. This merit badge class is not meant for those who just want to come and see what they can get done. Preparation is a MUST. Scouts will be signed off only on those requirements that the Merit Badge Counselor determines meets the requirements. This is an Eagle required Merit Badge and you should not expect to earn the badge without preparation and effort. We look forward to seeing you at the Museum.
