

Super Merit Badge Covid-19: North Star Museum

Since we are still in the midst of the Pandemic, with an abundance of caution these are the rules for face-to-face merit badge classes.

Parents must sign in their Scout outside the entrance from the parking lot and must wear masks. The sign in and out is placed on the clip board on the table. Parents may not enter the building to wait for their Scouts to finish the class. Parents who want to stay around should either stay in their car or bring a lawn chair to sit on. At the end of the class, they may pick up their Scout outside the building and sign out. If a Scout is driving themselves, please let the museum know in advance at barbcorti@gmail.com.

Everyone entering the building must fill out and sign the Covid-19 questionnaire. In the unlikely instance of a case of Covid-19 filling out and signing the form will be used for tracing.

All classes will take place in the area between Founders Hall and the exhibit areas. The remaining areas are off limits until further notice. The exception are the two bathrooms.

Scouts and Counselors:

- Anyone entering the building must use hand sanitizer which will be provided. Sanitizer must be used upon leaving the bathroom if you do not wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with soap.
- Everyone must wear a mask at all times. If you forget yours, we will have a limited number of disposable one.
- Everyone must maintain 6 feet of Social Distancing at all times (marks have been placed on the floor).
- No food may be brought in and none will be served (each participant will get a bottle of water)
- Other than the bathrooms the remainder of the museum is off limits.

Following the class, we will be sanitizing the bathrooms and any areas where people have gone. By following the above rules, you will make it easier on the person who must do the sanitizing.
