DESCRIPTION

Please note our new procedure: You must walk your Scout into the building and sign him both in and out of the workshop. If he has a driver's license, and you wish him to come alone, please let us know at least 24 hours in advance. That way, we can allow him to sign in and out himself.

NOTICE: The BSA requires that merit badge counsellors be convinced the scout has completed the merit badge requirements. The scout MUST be prepared with the following:

Preparation and completion of all requirements that can be completed prior to the initial session is essential. **The scout is expected to come prepared with the following:**

- Bring a copy of the Family Life merit badge pamphlet (OR, you can print out current requirements and worksheet <http://usscouts.org/mb/worksheets/Family-Life.pdf>. The actual pamphlet can be downloaded from the following site: <https://www.scouting.org/programs/scouts-bsa/advancement-and-awards/merit-badges/>. You will need to scroll down to find it.
- Read the pamphlet before the workshop and review the requirements (this is absolutely critical)
- Requirements 1 and 2: Arrive at this session with documentation for both requirements.
- Requirement 3: Have this list of chores in mind when you come to the workshop
- Requirement 4-5: If possible, discuss a project with your family prior to the workshop. You will have to discuss this with the Counselor at the workshop.
- Wear your Scout uniform
- Bring a properly filled out merit badge card, signed by your Scoutmaster

NOTE: You will not have completed all the requirements for your merit badge at the conclusion of this workshop. However, the counselor will be available to meet with you after you have completed Requirements 3-5. It will take you at least an additional 90 days to complete the badge.

Note: If you decide to cancel. You will need to do so one week prior to the workshop. Refunds are available through RegFox where you registered.
