Complete the following Requirements before class:

- Requirement 1, a and b: Get a tour of a library asking how the library is organized and what resources and services are offered. Learn how a library's card catalog or computerized catalog is used and searched. Then complete 1. c and d,
- Requirement 2 a and b using the information from number 1.
- Requirement 3. Read four different types of book and complete a., b., and c.
- Requirement 3-5: Complete each one. Question 5 can be completed by doing a little research on the Internet.
- Requirement 4: Read a nonfiction book and the project from the book.
- Requirement 5 involves learning about the world around you.

If you complete material after the workshop, you will need to have a confirmation from the Scoutmaster or a teacher. Please email the confirmation to me.

- Wear your Scout uniform,
- Bring with you a blank blue merit badge signed by your Scoutmaster.
- Bring your worksheet with you to keep you organized.
