- Read the Rifle Merit Badge pamphlet book. The pamphlet book may be purchased at Basecamp or on amazon.com for the Kindle. Make sure you get the most recent version.

- If you have a Firearms Safety Certification, bring it along with you
- Wear your Scout uniform
- *Bring a properly filled out merit badge card, signed by your Scoutmaster!*
