However, you can now visit the North Star Museum to fulfill this requirement but should do so in advance of the workshop. Due to the Covid 19 virus it may not be open

You can type in the answers on the sheet and then save it to your hard drive on your computer and or print it out. Your counselor is not requiring you to email it to him. - Concerning requirement 6, bring at least part of your collection to briefly show and explain to the group.
- Concerning requirement 7, teach and play the game with other Scouts prior to the merit badge workshop, and bring some part of the equipment to show and explain to the class.
- Concerning requirement 8, if you are not able to interview at least three people over age 40 who were Scouts, we will provide you with an opportunity to interview one of the three people at the workshop.
- Wear your Scout uniform
- Bring a properly filled-in and signed merit badge card
- Bring a pencil or pen

You are expected to do your best to meet each requirement. The class will be spent in group discussion with each Scout expected to participate. Registration closes August 6. After that time there will be no refund.

If you need to cancel, you need to do so by July 9. This will allow us to add someone from the waiting list. Go to the website where you registered to cancel.
